

- To provide ALL students a meaningful learning experience focusing on the priority standards




MODELS OF INSTRUCTION

DIGITAL LEARNING DAYS (PHASE II)

- Focus on **priority standards** beginning April 13th
- Implement virtual learning schedules that foster consistency in continuing the education plan for all students
- Communicate the virtual learning schedules to all stakeholders through email, calling posts, school website, etc.
