From Lynda Mauborgne, Principal, regarding Security Budget and Updates: The Georgia Department of Education (GaDOE) has tasked each school system to provide viable safety measures in the event of a security crisis.

1. Swipe card access to exterior door [approximately \$4,500 - \$7,000 per door] Facilities Security Measures
2. Digital walkie-talkie communication devices [approximately \$250 per device]
3. New or replacement perimeter fencing (6' high black vinyl coated chain link) [approximately \$30-\$40 per linear foot]
