The vendor was here last week to walk the field and measure for the fencing. It was decided by Mrs. Mauborgne (and the vendor agreed) that any existing fencing in good condition will not be replaced. Being a good steward of public funds and making our fencing dollars go farther is the reason, should someone ask about two different looks (old vs. new).
