

## **Oak Grove Elementary School Principal Advisory Council (PAC) Minutes**

### **Meeting Date: March 31, 2021**

A quorum of voting members was present for the Principal Advisory Council meeting held virtually at 9:00 AM Wednesday, March 31, 2021 via zoom.

### **Meeting commenced 9:00 AM**

1. **Call to Order** - Chairperson Ms. Wells called the meeting to order at 9:00 AM. K. Gaputis second.

2. **Agenda** – Ms. Wells

3. **Approval of agenda and the February minutes.**

B. Wuest made motion to approve minutes. (All in agreement.)

### **4. Standing Reports**

#### **a) Principal's Report**

##### **Attendance at 305:**

- 382 students enrolled.
- 70% F2F, 30% remain virtual - higher % of return rate for elementary schools.
- 27% of Oak Grove students lost to private schools – IHM, Cliff Valley, and Annunciation Day School.

##### **Staffing at OGE:**

- 7 certified staff members have resigned &/or retired.
- 4 staff members on leave from OGE.
- 2 paraprofessionals have resigned.

**Reopening:** B. Wuest suggested spaces zoned for mask-free eating & for students who choose to eat alone. Motion to generate a list of questions to be submitted to the Region II Superintendent &/or Covid Task Force. R. Brown second (All in agreement).

A. Wells asked if we have data regarding Covid-19 vaccinations of teachers. CDC mandates have changed from 6ft to 3ft student spacing, resulting in the largest classroom at OGE to be outfitted with individual Plexiglas shields for each student's workspace.

### **CSIP 2021-2022**

- 2020-2021: STEM, Math, Climate: attendance
- 2021-2022: Using baseline from 2019 and focusing on where we are as a school.
  - Continued focus on math – 1/2 time math resource teacher will be hired for the start of school, August 2021. The position will be similar to S. Welch, OGE Reading Coach.
  - CSIP will be posted to OGE website and shared with PAC.
  - L. Mauborgne shared that the current year MAP data is inconsistent given the level of parent support students received as they took the initial test AND the inconsistent testing environments in which students participated (I.E. virtual in fall, F2F only in winter, and hybrid in spring)
  - Learning loss concern shared by B. Wuest and k. Gaputis - L. Mauborgne shared that the leadership team is considering how to close the learning gaps, considering pacing and how we're approaching our instruction, revisiting the time spent on individual standards and weighing priorities.
- STEM recertification is coming March 2022.

### **Facilities**

- L. Mauborgne shared previous conversations about HVAC system providing sufficient ventilation and that the district has ensured buildings' HVAC systems are efficient and functioning well and that we continue to follow their guidance, such as keeping windows closed to prevent the system from being overworked.
- A. Wells asked about the roof and ceiling leaks. This year, we have not had roof leaks for the first time in many years.
- 5 years last assessment regarding plumbing - \$325,000. Work has not been done. B. Wells motion for a study comparing local schools.

R. Smith second (All in Agreement). Oak Grove ES roof and windows replacement funded by Splost has not been done.

- **Facility Condition Assessment** to be posted to the DCSD website by April 2, 2021.

**B. Well & R. Smith - Town Hall Meeting:**

Many parents shared frustrations over priorities, such as magnet schools and special programs versus building structure. There could be new builds coming, or combining of schools.

R. Smith motion to rally parent voice by orchestrating a media campaign designed to bring current issues and conditions to light regarding facility condition and redistricting potentially supporting super-sized elementary schools. B. Wuest second. R. Smith to contact the PTA presidents and the OGE Foundation (All in agreement).

**Each member of the PAC expressed their heartfelt appreciation for the extraordinary effort and dedication to student instruction demonstrated by the faculty and staff at Oak Grove ES throughout this school year. The students are learning and happy!**
