

Oak Grove Elementary School Principal's Advisory Council (PAC) Minutes

Meeting Date: December 9, 2021

A quorum of voting members was present for the Principal Advisory Council meeting held virtually at 9:00 AM Wednesday, December 9, 2021 via zoom.

PAC Members Present: Robyn Brown (Teacher Representative), Kelly Gaputis (Parent Representative), Lynda Mauborgne (Principal), Linda Stuhr (Teacher Representative), Angela Wells (Chair), Bill Wuest (Parent Representative)

PAC Members Absent: Selena Sanders

1. Call to Order - Chairperson Ms. Wells called the meeting to order at 9:00 AM. Second Ms. Mauborgne.
2. Agenda – Ms. Wells
3. Approval of agenda and the October 28 minutes. PAC Vice Chair nominations: Ms. Gaputis to nominate Bill Wuest. Second Ms. Brown. Unanimous.

4. Standing Reports

a) Principal's Report

Ms. Mauborgne shared Oak Grove ES enrollment numbers:

- As of Friday, December 5 – 390 (down from 523)
- Virtual attendance – student rate 94%, teacher rate - 97%.

FTEs are down considerably. Future repercussions are unclear. Families are seeking F2F in smaller private school settings. Ms. Wells – Cliff Valley and IHM are adding classrooms to accommodate parents seeking F2F instruction.

CSIP – Oak Grove is constantly working on our instructional goals as it relates to the school improvement plan – revisions are not needed at this time.

Facilities - Ms. Nisha Wagner, PTA president responded to PAC member's requests for support in addressing ongoing issues. An email campaign to DCSD key players in building upkeep and renovations is underway. Communications via room parents will begin January 1, 2021. Ms. Mauborgne is in agreement and felt the timing was good with the schoolhouse being empty at this time. Vote unanimous.

There are ongoing school foundation issues being addressed by the DCSD Plant Operations Coordinator – Sam A. Moss Service Center. Arthur Kinder the Service Manager for Region 2 is the contact person for this project.

b) Teacher Reports

Concern expressed regarding building condition – structural, upkeep and cleanliness.

c) Parent Reports

Ms. Wells and Ms. Gaputis shared highlights from DCSD PAC Cross-Council event.

Ms. Wells and Mr. Wuest expressed concern over parent feedback in regards to continued virtual instruction. Ms. Gaputis noted that families with the means to do so have hired tutors to keep up with learning. Ms. Mauborgne - the teachers are working hard addressing the challenges of online instruction and have done an exceptional job mirroring the brick + mortar learning environment at OGE.
